Where do we begin? The last two months have been a whirlwind of activity: getting our paperwork in order; packing, selling, or giving away all of our earthly belongings; saying goodbye to friends and family; and... stepping into a new culture, vastly different from our own.

Thank you to all of you who came to the worship night we held on August 20th. You were, and continue to be, an amazing encouragement to us. Thank you also to those of you who helped us pack and move. We really couldn't have done this without you - and also kept our health and sanity!

## New Beginnings

During our first few weeks in Japan, we stayed at "Seaside Chapel", which is the church that we will be helping to establish in its new community during the first part of our tenure here. Since our arrival we have felt so loved and cared for by Higa Sensei (the pastor of Seaside Chapel) and Tsuneko Sensei (his wife). They have really taken us under their wing, and truly are examples of

In the meantime, it's amazing to see how God has specially equipped us to serve in Japan, and with Seaside Chapel in particular. In some instances they have been praying for someone to come along (e.g., to teach violin) for the past year, only to find that we can meet that need in some way (e.g., Peter can teach violin).

On October 2nd we moved into the new apartment which the church had found for us. We are living on the top floor of a four-story building which promises to make us fitter (no elevator), and are really enjoying finally having a place to call home. Across the street from us is a lovely park, and nearby we have a post office (where we do our banking), grocery store, karaoke, and Okinawan soba restaurant.

We have now given our greeting gifts to our neighbours (maple tea, from PEI), and are looking forward to continuing those relationships in the weeks and months to come.
